Classroom Fee	First Grade Consumable material	\$15 per year	To cover Scholastic News, My Journal, writing dictionary and folder.	Required items/materials or a comparable alternative will be provided. Students will not be excluded from classroom activities if the fee is unpaid
Classroom Fee	Second Grade Consumable material	\$15 per year	To cover Story Works Junior, Studies Weekly, Scholastic News, and folders.	Required items/materials or a comparable alternative will be provided. Students will not be excluded from classroom activities if the fee is unpaid
Classroom Fee	Third Grade Consumable material	\$15 per year	To cover Scholastic News, planners, and folders.	Required items/materials or a comparable alternative will be provided. Students will not be excluded from classroom activities if the fee is unpaid
Classroom Fee	Fourth Grade Consumable material	\$15 per year	To cover planners, folders, Story Works and Studies Weekly.	Required items/materials or a comparable alternative will be provided. Students will not be excluded from classroom activities if the fee is unpaid
Classroom Fee	Fifth Grade Consumable material	\$15 per year	To cover Storyworks, Studies Weekly, folders, binder, and planners.	Required items/materials or a comparable alternative will be provided. Students will not be excluded from classroom activities if the fee is unpaid
Course Fee	Field Trip Fee	Varies by field trip – See field trip sponsor	To cover cost or a portion of the cost of admission and transportation. Fee is relative to cost of field trip.	A comparable alternative may be provided. With prior arrangement, a student who desires to participate in class field trip will not be excluded if the fee is unpaid
User Fee	District issued personal mobile technology device	\$50 per school year	To offset a portion of the leasing cost of devices and to insure against theft, damage, or loss	Student will not be issued a personal mobile technology device

Beginning in 2015-16, a student fee schedule specific to each school shall be posted to the school website in a prescribed location and shall be updated annually.
